What is the learner dashboard?

The learner dashboard is a new feature on the Mindtools Content Hub, designed to give your learners greater visibility into their own learning activity, while giving your learning programs added depth, transparency and engagement.

The dashboard sits within the learner's profile section via the 'Me' icon and is accessed from the 'My Learning' option on the drop-down menu. It provides them with a personalized view of how they are engaging with the content available to them.

What learners can see

Activity Insights

A visual overview of engagement to date, including:

- a **bar chart** displaying resources accessed and learning time over a selected date range
- flexible date filters (e.g. this week, last month, custom range)
- **interactive elements** (hover over the charts to see detailed data points for each day/week/month/year)

Additional dashboards highlight:

- the top five **categories** accessed
- the most popular resource types (e.g. videos, articles, audio interviews)

These insights help your learners reflect on their habits, identify preferred formats and stay engaged with their development.

Learning History

A detailed log of every resource a learner has interacted with, including:

- resource title (clickable to revisit content)
- resource **type**
- date last viewed
- estimated **learning time** (based on standard consumption duration, not tracked time on page)

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Why this matters for you

The learner dashboard enhances the value of your learning offering by:

- **Driving learner autonomy**: users can monitor their own progress, revisit key resources and take more ownership of their personal learning journey.
- Encouraging consistent engagement: visual feedback and easy access to past activity support the formation of good learning habits and continuous development.
- Supporting coaching and performance conversations: learners come better prepared to reflect on their development and can set more meaningful goals with their managers.
- Enabling a culture of self-directed learning: this dashboard complements curated learning pathways by giving learners the space to explore and track their own interests.

It's not just about tracking usage – it's about empowering learners and deepening impact.
